June 16th

GUALACEO - MENDEZ -

#### CHINIMBIMI:

DAY 3


June 18th

**EL PANGUI:** 

El Pangui well known also like the 'Orchid of the amazon'. This is a small town located in the south of the Ecuadorian amazon basin, here it is located the Ecuagenera nursery, where we grow a great number of aroids species and miniature orchids. Also there is place dedicated for conservation, where we will find different species, not only Ecuadorian but also from other parts of the world. We will spend the night in the same place El Pangui.









## June 19th

#### **EL PANGUI - ZAMORA:**

This day we will be leaving El Pangui and traveling to Zamora, on the way we will visit part of the Cordillera del Condor area, this is an eastern mountain range of the Andes that is shared and forms part of the international border between Ecuador and Peru. Here we will see orchids such as Rodriguezia, Epidendrum, Masdevallia, Lepanthes, Stelis, Maxillaria, Sobralia, Eriopsis and more. We will spend the night in Zamora.



# DAY 5

#### June 20th

#### **ZAMORA - LOJA:**

We will leave the Amazon side to go back to the Andes. On the way we will find different types of orchids on the road, like Masdevallia, Sobralia, Eriopsis, Maxillaria, Phragmipedium, Vanilla, Cyrtochilum, Oncidium and Prosthechea. We will spend the night in Loja.



# DAY 6

#### June 21th

### LOJA - SARAGURO:

We will take the old road and on the way we will see Fernandezia, Telipogon, Cyrtochilum Oncidium, and Epidendrum. Also we will live the traditions of Saraguro's ethnic group. We will spend the night in Saraguro.

We will start our trip back to Gualaceo and on the way we will see some orchids in the roadside like Trichoceros, Oncidium, Telipogon, Lepanthes, Andinias, etc. We will spend the night in Gualaceo.

Today we stay at the nursery, with thousands of different orchids. It is probably the largest collection of Andean orchids in the world. In the afternoon we will visit Chordeleg one of places famous because of handicrafts and silver and gold jewelry. We will spend the night in Gualaceo.



DAY 9


June 24th

# **RECCOMENDATIONS:**

All countries (except Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Eritrea, Ethiopia, China, Kenya, Nepal, Nigeria, Pakistan, Somalia) do not require a VISA. A passport with at least 6 months validity is required.

The local currency is USD and you will find Currency Exchange points at the airports. We recommend you travel with cash and credit card. Travellers checks are not accepted.

In order to avoid inconvenience during the trip we suggest you bring: waterproof walking shoes or **rubber boots**, rain coats, mosquito repellent and sunscreen, as well as basic medication for general problems such as altitude sickness and stomachache. Bring your personal medication; it could be difficult to find the same here.

We recommend you to be prepare for the variation of climate. We are going to experience the chill of high altitudes and warmth and humidity of Amazon. The weather in our country is unpredictable; it could be sunny and 5 min later rainy.

IMPORTANT: According to the regulations of the Ministry of Environment of Ecuador, is not allowed to collect or extract seeds, plants, or any biological resource from nature.
