

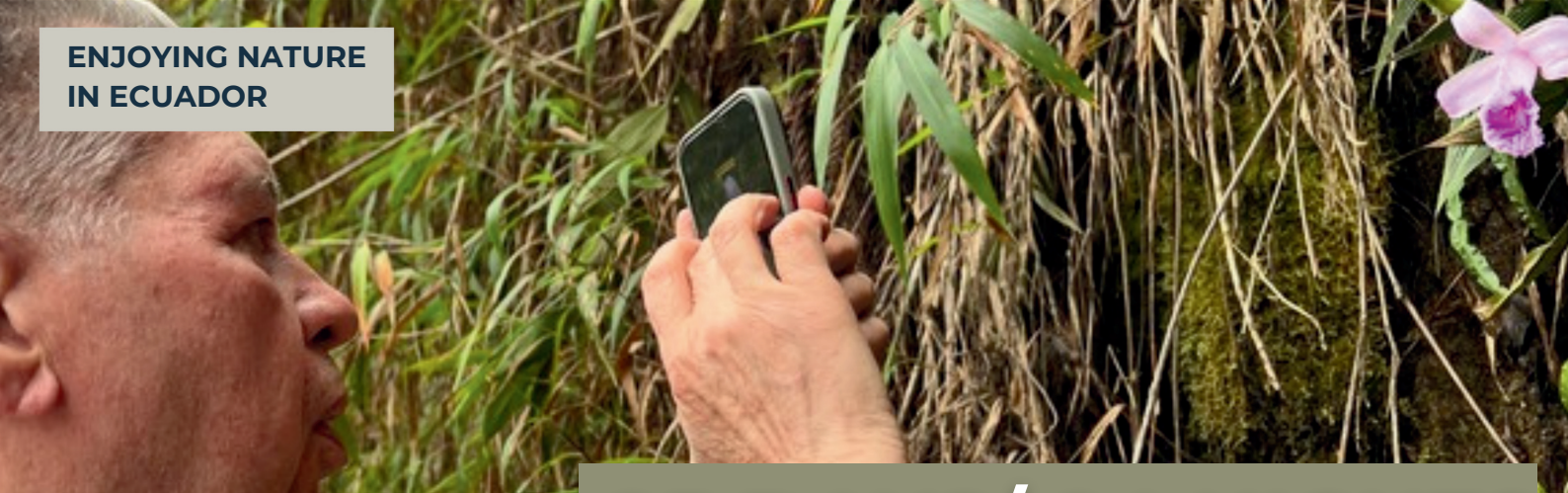
ORCHID SHORT TOUR

Ecuador's privileged geographic location has positioned it as one of the most biodiverse countries worldwide. Its territory ranges from stunning coastal regions with inviting beaches ideal for relaxing vacations, ascending to altitudes exceeding 4,000 meters in the Andes mountains. Crossing this majestic mountain range leads travelers to the Amazon Basin, a region abundant with diverse flora and fauna awaiting exploration. Ecuador is home to approximately 1,660 bird species, countless vibrant insects, and around 4,400 orchid species described scientifically. Additionally, the presence of 16 distinct ethnic groups enhances the travel experience through remarkable cultural diversity.

> CUENCA - UZHUPUD GARDEN DAY1

The tour starts in Cuenca. We'll pick you up at the Cuenca Airport to explore this UNESCO World Heritage city. Afterward, we'll head to the Uzhupud Garden facilities.



> ECUAGENERA GUALACEO DAY 2

"On this day, we'll visit the Ecuagenera facilities in Gualaceo to discover many kinds of orchids and learn about their cultivation. In the afternoon, we'll drive to Chordeleg to explore its artisan jewelry shops."



> UZHUPUD - EL PANGUI DAY 3

After breakfast, we'll depart for the Amazon—home to countless orchids and tropical plants that we can observe in their natural habitat—journeying through the Andes until we reach El Pangui. We'll stay overnight in El Pangui.

After breakfast, we'll visit the Ecuagenera facilities in El Pangui. This place houses a vast collection of plants, including orchids, bromeliads, and Araceae. DAY 5

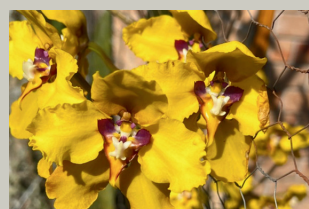
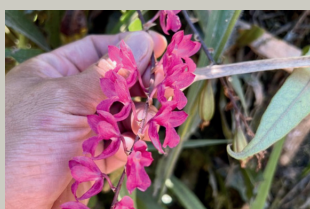
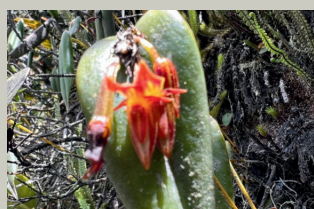

Our tour will conclude at the end of the day.



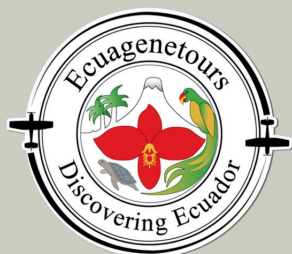

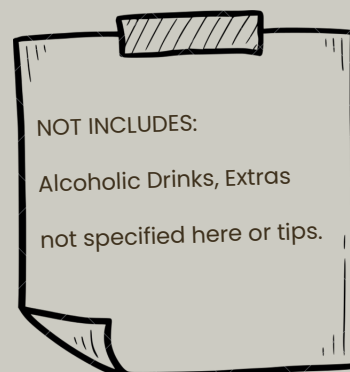

TRAVEL RECOMMENDATIONS AND PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Visa Requirements:

Visitors from most countries do not require a visa to enter Ecuador, with the exception of nationals from the following countries: Nigeria, Nepal, Pakistan, Somalia, China, Bangladesh, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Kenya. A passport valid for at least six months beyond your date of entry is mandatory for all travelers.

Currency Information:

The official currency in Ecuador is the US Dollar (USD). Currency exchange facilities are available at international airports. We recommend traveling with a combination of cash (USD) and credit cards. Note that traveler's checks are not accepted.

Climate and Clothing Recommendations:

We advise travelers to be prepared for significant climate variations. The tour includes areas with high-altitude chill in the Andes and the warm, humid conditions of the Amazon Basin. Ecuadorian weather can be highly unpredictable, shifting from sunny to rainy within minutes. Layered clothing and waterproof gear are strongly recommended.
